**Natural Resources Committee**  
Meeting Minutes  
June 9, 2010

Chairman Mulrooney called the meeting to order at 4:01 p.m. Members present included Representatives Hocker, Outten, D. E. Williams, Carey, Atkins. Rep. Briggs-King was also present. There were no other guests present.

After calling the meeting to order, Chairman Mulrooney chose to address **SB 183 w/SA 1 AN ACT TO AMEND TITLE 7, CHAPTER 5 OF THE DELAWARE CODE RELATING TO GAME PRESERVES** and acknowledged Senator McBride as the bill's sponsor. Rep. Mulrooney explained that this bill removes the word "experimental" as it appears in Title 7, Chapter 5 of the Delaware Code because it is not defined.

Rep. Hocker moved to release the bill; Rep. Atkins seconded the motion. The bill was released from committee on a 0-10-0 vote.

Lastly, Chairman Mulrooney chose to address **HB 437 AN ACT TO AMEND TITLE 7 OF THE DELAWARE CODE RELATING TO HUNTING, TRAPPING, AND FISHING LICENSES** and recognized Rep. Briggs-King as the bill's sponsor. Rep. Briggs-King explained that this bill allows an active duty member of the U.S. Armed Services to be deemed a resident of the state for the purpose of obtaining a Delaware hunting, trapping, or fishing license. She stated that this is a good way to thank the people serving in the armed forces.

Rep. Mulrooney added that there will be an amendment added to include the people who serve in the Coast Guard.

Rep. Hocker moved to release the bill; Rep. Atkins seconded the motion. The bill was released from committee on a 0-10-0 vote.

Chairman Mulrooney adjourned the meeting at 4:04.
