**Veterans Affairs Committee**  
Meeting Minutes  
June 22, 2010

Chairman Jaques called the meeting to order at 1:07 p.m. Members present included Reps. Q. Johnson, Carson, Brady and George. For a list of guests, please see the attached document.

Chairman Jaques referred to Rep. Carson to introduce **HB 483, AN ACT TO AMEND TITLE 20 OF THE DELAWARE CODE RELATING TO THE DELAWARE NATIONAL GUARD**. Rep. Carson stated that the bill was brought about by a constituent that was activated for duty and sent to Afghanistan for a year. When the constituent returned, he was required to pay late fees for the renewal of state-issued licenses. This bill would thus waive any late fees for the renewal of state-issued licenses for National Guard members and reservists who are called to active duty outside of the state. He clarified that these licenses include driver's licenses or hunting and fishing licenses, etc.

Rep. George and Rep. Q. Johnson voiced their support of the legislation.

Rep. George motioned to release the bill. Rep. Brady seconded the motion. The bill was released from committee with seven favorable votes and three votes on its merits.

Without any additional questions or comments, Rep. Jaques adjourned the committee at 1:10 p.m.
